The advantage is that with a standard 8 team rolling knockout a team losing the first game cannot finish higher than fifth so a large number of games lose their competitive edge. With this format a team losing the first game can still finish as high as 3rd and to finish in the top 4 you have to win 2 of the 3 games. A disadvantage is that this system leaves 2 teams in equal 3rd (or they can be split on points difference).
